



REJUVENATION OF THE VICTOR DAITZ INFORMATION GATEWAY

The Victor Daitz Chair in HIV/TB Research is pleased to announce the rejuvenation of the 'Victor Daitz Information Gateway'.

The Gateway, which will be hosted by the University of KwaZulu-Natal, will take the form of a web-based information portal which will host a collection of the latest scientific literature on HIV/AIDS and TB research, with a specific focus on clinical and basic science research.

The Gateway will also enable electronic access to a selection of reputable journals relevant to HIV/AIDS and TB research (including *Science*, *Nature*, *Journal of Virology*, and *Infection and Immunity*) through the University library system.

'Open Access' Support for UKZN Researchers

As part of the Gateway initiative, the Victor Daitz Chair in HIV/TB Research wishes to provide support to UKZN HIV and TB researchers publishing in Open Access journals.

UKZN researchers, publishing basic science and/or clinical research in HIV/AIDS and TB, who have had a manuscript accepted in an Open Access journal with an ISI impact factor of 5 and above, are therefore invited to apply to the Gateway for financial support to publish in an Open Access journal.

Interested persons should email (1) the abstract, and (2) a letter from the scientific journal, confirming acceptance of their manuscript for publication in an Open Access journal, to Ms Tarryn Leslie < Leslie@ukzn.ac.za >, Ext. 4763.

Ten articles per year will be selected for support through this initiative.
