Professor Eugene Coyle is Dean of the Military Technical College of the Sultanate of Oman. He was previously a faculty member at Dublin Institute of Technology over a period of several years, and held the positions including Head of School of Electrical Engineering Systems and Head of External Research Engagement before taking up his current post in Oman.

Dr Eugene spent one academic year (2011-12) as a visiting Fulbright Scholar at Purdue University's Global Policy Research Institute in Indiana. His research at Purdue resulted in a book titled "Understanding the Global Energy Crisis".

Edited by Eugene Coyle and Richard A. Simmons, the book brings together experts in energy policy, social science, power systems, solar energy, agronomy, renewable energy technologies, nuclear engineering, transportation, and the built environment from both sides of the Atlantic to explore the future of energy production and consumption from technological, political, and sociological perspectives.
