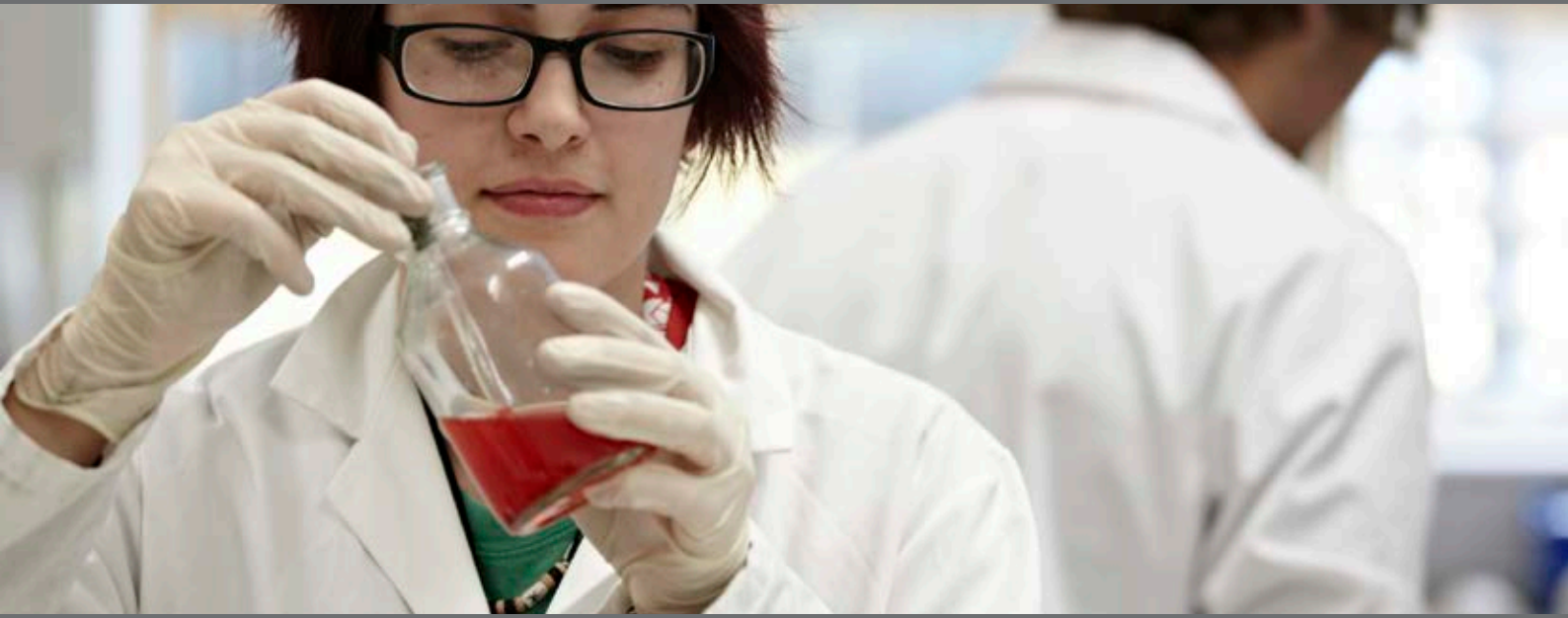


Certificate in Forensic Investigation



The Certificate in Forensic Investigation aims to equip professionals with the skills to undertake forensic investigations with the appreciation of legal, ethical and industrial relations implications.

How you will benefit. You will learn to:

- Display an understanding of basic accounting, law and computer concepts needed for forensic investigations
- Demonstrate a knowledge of the essential statutes, laws, practices and principles required for forensic investigations
- Demonstrate a competency in the principles, planning and preparation of basic investigative reports

Who should attend:

The course is suitable for investigators of government departments (SARS; Department of Transport; Customs, etc.); lower level police officials; parastatal employees (Parks Board office; Eskom, Telkom, etc.); forensic departments of private organisations and educational institutions; private investigators and accountants or attorneys.
