Applicants may also drop off their applications at the CTO offices (chemistry and physics) at the PMB campus no later than **22<sup>nd</sup> January 2017**.

**Successful applicants will undergo formal training in SI before their sessions begin.**

#### Minimum requirements

The applicants must:

- be a registered student for at least the first semester of 2017.
- **(Applications should still be sent even if registration is currently pending)**
- be a Chemistry **or** Physics Major.
- be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> academic year or above (i.e. having completed all 2<sup>nd</sup> year modules for the respective major).
- have achieved 65% or above in the module they are applying to be an SI leader for
- be confident and willing to assist others.
- have 3½ -5 hours per week for SI.
