## Inter-Bursary Support Programme

### CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Department of Science and Technology (DST) and the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) invite applications for a bursary under the DST-CSIR Inter-Bursary Support Programme (IBS) grant scheme.



**Who should apply?** The IBS postgraduate bursary is intended for full-time studies for Honours, Masters or PhD degrees at any South African public university. Students who intend to register for their fourth year in Engineering or BTech degrees will also be considered.

Applications must include endorsement and motivation by the nominated supervisor for masters and doctoral students, or postgraduate office in the case of Honours/BTech/fourth year Engineering students.
