The successful incumbent will lead the setup, implementation and management of data management systems in line with study protocols and Standard Operating Procedures. Ensure that clinical data management services are delivered in a consistent, high-quality, and timely manner and ensure efficient data flow within the clinical site, by having a continuous oversight of the clinical data. This position involves daily interaction with all clinical staff at all investigational sites to guide staff on CRF / SD completion and correction of the clinical database in accordance with the edit check / logic check specifications.

**Qualifications and experience:** Grade 12; Relevant degree or 3 year diploma (IT, Computer programming); 1 year data management experience; Experience in clinical trial environment is preferable; Database programming in SQL on any relational database system (e.g. MSSQL, MySQL, Oracle,FoxPro and/or Access); Computer programming language (preferably C-Programming); In depth understanding of data management practices and tools; DataFax or another clinical data management system (e.g. Oracle Clinical, Medidata, Epidata) is preferred; In depth understanding of the research environment and clinical data management practices and tools is preferred; Familiarity with coding dictionaries e.g. MeDDRA and WHODRUG is preferred
