**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Accompany study participants home following accrual to confirm locator information
- Maintain up-to-date confidential participant contact logs and locator information data
- Remind participants about scheduled visits
- Conduct home visits for participants who have missed visits.
- Be an active member of the research project including attending all training sessions on relevant study procedures and protocols
