

PAMSA BURSARY PROGRAMME CALLS FOR APPLICATIONS

The Paper Manufacturers Association of South Africa (PAMSA) is calling for applications from post-graduate chemical engineering students* for its Master of Engineering (M.Eng.) study programme which facilitates bursaries and scholarships for eligible applicants. Value of bursary: R100,000 per year for two years full time study of M.Eng. degree.

Applications are welcome from post-graduate chemical engineering students who meet the following requirements:

- BSc. Eng. (chemical engineering) candidates interested in enrolling for M.Eng. studies in the bio-technology space of the pulp, paper and packaging industry.
- A good academic record with a minimum 60% average in the final year of study.
- Applicants must have completed their studies in five years or less.
- Candidates should indicate their areas of interest, for example energy efficiency, renewable energy and biopolymers etc.
- South African citizenship an advantage.
