- Asia: All Analyst interview rounds will take place in October. Positions in the Mumbai, New Delhi, and Singapore locations are only available to candidates who do not require sponsorship for local work authorization.
- **Europe:** Geneva, London, and Paris Candidates who apply by October 2nd and are selected for interviews should anticipate that all first-round interviews will be on Thursday 11 October and all second-round interviews on Thursday 18 October.
