Biography

Professor Mogobe Bernard Ramose was born in South Africa. He was subsequently granted political asylum in Belgium where he obtained the degree of Doctor of Philosophy from Louvain University, (KUL). Prior to this he obtained the Master of Science degree (International Relations) from the University of London.

He lectured particularly in philosophy of law, philosophy of religion, ethics and African philosophy in universities in Western Europe and Africa. He published several articles including a monograph, *African philosophy through ubuntu*. He is currently Research Professor in the Department of Clinical Psychology, Sefako Makgatho Health Sciences University in Ga-Rankuwa, South Africa.
