We also seek ways to improve diagnosis, prevention and treatment. To achieve this, we bring together leading researchers from different fields, use cutting edge science to improve people's health, and help to train the next generation of African scientists. Our research is truly collaborative: we work with over 60 academic and clinical institutions in South Africa, and elsewhere in Africa and the world. AHRI's major funders are Wellcome Trust and the Howard Hughes Medical Institute. Our academic partners are the University of KwaZulu-Natal (UKZN) and University College London.

Brief overview of the position:

Research Scientist will be responsible for day to day management of social science projects under the guidance of the project investigators and senior social scientists. This carries responsibility for managing both social and clinical science data including contributing to analysis, dissemination at national and international conferences. The postholder will contribute to the writing of the protocols, obtaining ethics and regulatory approvals for these studies, draft project documents, funder reports and presentations as well as supervising the quality control and assurance processes.
