Minimum requirements

The applicants must:

- be a registered student of UKZN for semester 1 of 2019. (Applications should still be sent even if registration is currently pending)
- be on a good academic standing (green) and must have their research supervisors' approval (in the case of postgrads).
- be in the 3rd academic year or higher
- preferably be majoring in the subject they choose to apply for
- have achieved 65% or above in the module you want to be an SI leader for.
- be confident and willing to assist others.
- be able to dedicate 4 -5 hours per week to the SI program.
