







BLENDED LEARNING: DIGITAL TEACHING IN HIGHER EDUCATION

The course is based on the Activated Classroom Teaching (ACT) approach which is a taxonomy of 5 pedagogies (teaching approaches) that have been demonstrated to be effective in the digital age.
