The Centre for Communication, Media and Society is a premier African postgraduate research and teaching unit in the School of Applied Human Sciences. The Centre specializes in media histories; broadcasting, newspaper and new media studies; cultural heritage and tourism; culture and identity studies; development communication; public health communication.

The discipline of CCMS has a vacancy for **two lecturers** specializing in either the area of i) **Media and Cultural studies and/or ii) Health Communication** at postgraduate level. S/he will also be expected to contribute to:

- Lectures (under mentorship): Research Methodology from a cultural and media studies perspective and/or Health Communication.
- Assist with teaching Honours research projects (Special Topics) across one of the three research tracks: Cultural studies, Media studies and/or Health Communication
- Assist with Honours module coordination, administration, supervision and grading
- Assist with the supervision of Masters students in media and cultural studies and/or health communication
- Participate actively in the weekly colloquium, including the role of reviewer for student proposals.
- Assist with general discipline administration
- Assist with the administration of the discipline Website, Facebook page, Alumni lists, Turnitin set up and reports, staff-student liaison meetings etc
- Assist with Honours fieldtrip (if held)
- Register for a PhD (if not already registered or in possession of a PhD).

- Good quality Masters' degree in Media and Cultural studies with specialization in Health Communication
- Evidence of lecturing and/or tutoring at tertiary level
- Evidence of an emerging publication record /scholarship
- Evidence of supervision of research projects/topics at the Honours level.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENT LECTURER IN MEDIA/CULTURAL STUDIES (One post):**

- Good quality Masters' degree in Media and/or Cultural Studies
- Evidence of lecturing and/or tutoring at tertiary level
- Evidence of an emerging publication record /scholarship
- Evidence of supervision of research projects/topics at the Honours level.
