What you will need:

- Lots of Paper (can be scrap paper)
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Glue and/or tape

- Paper to write on and a pen
- A clean piece of Styrofoam (e.g from a cup), or a slab of chocolate
- lodine, adult supervision is advisable
- Vinegar
- Water
- Pipette, syringe or straw
- Small glass
- Plastic gloves (lodine stains)
- Spoon
- Cornstarch or custard powder
- Bicarbonate
- Crème of Tartar
- Salt
- Sugar
- a plate or saucer
- Paper and/or kitchen paper towels

What you will need:

- A paper/plastic/ Styrofoam cup or yoghurt container
- AA batteries (2)
- One 2xAA battery holder
- 3 volt DC motor

- 1 paper clip, or safety pin
- 4 felt pens
- Double sided foam tape
- Insulation tape or tape
- Large piece of paper
