## **Minimum Qualifying criteria:**

1. Registered Entity.
2. Size of Entity: Exempted Micro-Enterprise (EME) or Qualify Small Enterprises (QSE).
3. Minimum Ownership Requirement of Entity: Ownership 51% Black South African from Designated Groups.

## **Definitions of B-BBEE Terms**

- 1. EME:** Revenue of the entity should be less than or equal to R10 million
- 2. QSE:** Revenue of the entity should be more than R10m and less than or equal to R50 million.
- 3. Black South African from Designated Groups:**
  - i. Black South Africans who are persons with disabilities as defined in the Code of Good Practice on employment of people with disabilities issued under the Employment Equity Act and/or;
  - ii. Black South Africans living in rural and underdeveloped areas and/or;
  - iii. Black South African military veterans who qualify to be called a military veteran in terms of the Military Veterans Act 18 of 2011 and/or;
  - iv. Unemployed Black South Africans not required by law to attend an educational institution and not awaiting admission to an educational institution and/or;
  - v. Black South Africans who are youth as defined in the National Youth Commission Act of 1996
- 4. Black South African including race groups:**
  - i. Black: African
  - ii. Black: Coloured
  - iii. Black: Indian
