Postgraduate bursaries in the College of Agriculture, Engineering and Science

The College of Agriculture, Engineering and Science must identify potential candidates for the following bursaries arising from funds from donors.

Bursaries:

1. Donald Moor (Agriculture or Agricultural Management)

Eligibility: South African students currently registered for an MSc in Agriculture or MSc in Agricultural Management and have a credit weighted average in Honours of 65% or greater.

2. Reino Stegen (Mechanical Engineering)

Eligibility: You must be registered for either an MScEng or PhD in Mechanical Engineering with a credit weighted average of 65% or higher in your previous degree. Preference will be given to graduates of UKZN.

3. TB Davis (Engineering)

Eligibility: Engineering graduates of UKZN currently registered for an MScEng in Agricultural Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Land Surveying and Mechanical Engineering with a credit weighted average of 65% or greater in your BScEng degree.

4. John Travers (Horticulture)

Eligibility: must be currently registered for an MSc or PhD in Horticulture and have a credit weighted average of 65% or greater in your previous degree.

The amount of each bursary will be determined by the panel and dependent on donor funds.

Apply with a cover letter, clearly stating the bursary you are applying for in the subject line and indicate how you meet the eligibility criteria. Please also indicate the source and amounts of any other bursaries or scholarships you currently hold in your cover letter. Include as attachments, (a) proof of registration and (b) your most recent academic record. All documents must be in one complete pdf file using your surname and student number separated by an underscore as the file name (e.g. Surname_221789675).
