

The development of an entrepreneurial ecosystem framework for public universities in South Africa

Demographical questions will be used for sample description purposes and will be reported in aggregate form.

Inclusion criteria for participation:

- Academic staff in the field of entrepreneurship and business management, responsible for transferring entrepreneurial/business knowledge and skills to students.
- Entrepreneurial support staff members associated with entrepreneurial development within the institution.
- Deans, deputy deans, directors, heads of departments (HODs) or programme leaders in the school or departments of management, business or entrepreneurship as the strategic thinkers and decision-makers of entrepreneurial development. Directors or managers of entrepreneurship centres, incubators, science parks and technology transfer offices as implanters of the entrepreneurial vision.
- You must be a full-time employee at your institution.
- You must at least be employed for a minimum of three years in your current role.
- You must have ticked the informed consent box at the end of this letter.
- Your only responsibility as a willing participant will be to participate in this voice-recorded interview.

Important notices, terms and conditions:

- The study is part of a post-graduate qualification and is conducted by NWU.
- Any personal identifying information, such as demographics, will remain confidential.
- This interview is voluntary, and you are under no obligation to participate in it.
- There will be no negative consequences to you if you do not participate in the interview.

The findings will also provide an entrepreneurial ecosystem framework for public universities in South Africa. The final copy of the full report findings will be held by NWU. Furthermore, the anonymised data and results may be used for peer-reviewed academic publications in journals or to present at conferences. 
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
