As we prepare for the 44th Annual SAACDHE Conference, we share the call for abstracts. Please refer to the "Call for Abstracts" noting the Conference theme and subthemes.

Abstract submission guide:

All presentations should encourage participation, initiate thought-provoking ideas and questions, and create an engaging atmosphere.

Three types of conference submissions are considered in this year's conference. Please ensure that you follow the abstract submission guidelines for conferences on the SAACHDE website. Herewith a brief overview:

- **Conceptual paper**: A conceptual paper focuses on the essence of an idea, laying the groundwork for further development and evaluation. A conceptual abstract submission should include: A statement; share key explorative strategies and explore findings and impact.
- **Research paper**: A research paper presents the research undertaken, analysis and interpretation of data. A research abstract submission should include, the statement or research problem, unpack methodology (design, sample, data collection and analysis, ethical clearance), explore key findings.
- Workshop: workshops aim to teach specific skills, demonstrate processes, or showcase a key concept, offering delegate engagement and participation with hands-on learning. A workshop submission should include a description of the workshop, relevance for counselling and development, key learning outcomes, duration needed for successful implementation, and a maximum number of delegates.

Abstract tips:

Provide a concise, coherently written and developed abstract on good research principles, practitioner experiences or data.

Abstracts are reviewed based on 4 criteria:

- Relevant to the conference themes
- Abstract offers a clear background, statement, overview of findings, discussions and recommendations
- Follows the structure of abstract submission
- Contributes significantly to the practices within student development and counselling
- Adheres to the abstract word count

- Submission of full paper for publication in the JCDHESA: 14 October 2024
