This project emphasizes stakeholder engagement to ensure the intervention is both context-specific and sustainable.

The successful candidate will engage with adolescents, caregivers, and government officials from the Department of Health, Department of Education, and Department of Social Development. Additionally, the study involves collaboration with academics from other national and international institutions.

Eligibility criteria:

- A doctorate in Psychology, Development Studies, Anthropology and other relevant Social Science fields.
- Eligible applicants must have completed their doctorate within the past 5 years.
- The applicant should not be older than 45 years at the closing date of applications.
- Experience in qualitative research with adolescents and young people.
- Strong interest and experience in conducting participatory research.

- Strong analytical and writing skills in English.
- A research track report and minimum of 1 peer review journal article.
- Experience conducting qualitative data analysis using software such as Nvivo, ATLAS.ti, etc.
- Be based at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, Westville Campus for the duration of the scholarship.
- A valid driver's licence and the ability to travel for work.
- Fluency in isiZulu
