

### TITLE OF THE STUDY:

# TRANSITIONING FROM FACE-TO-FACE TO ONLINE TEACHING DURING THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC: EXPERIENCES OF LECTURERS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF KWA-ZULU NATAL.

### Purpose of the study:
