CONDITIONS OF AWARD
UKZN PRESTIGE SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP

A. ENTRANTS

Prestige Sports Scholarships are available annually and will cover full tuition costs at the University of KwaZulu-Natal.

1. CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1.1 Only South African citizens intending to register as full-time students at the University of KwaZulu-Natal are eligible to apply.
- 1.2 The criterion for the award shall be achievement in sport at a National or Provincial level.
- 1.3 Preference will be given to sporting codes which are supported by the university.
- 1.4 Entrant Sports Scholarship awards are based on the recipients being accepted by the School or College.
- 1.5 The recipient must become an active member of the appropriate University of KwaZulu-Natal club and must be a regular player/ competitor throughout the season, and must attend coaching sessions and/or competitions as requested by the club. Failure to observe any of these conditions will result in the cancellation of the scholarship.
- 1.6 Candidates with exceptional achievements such as obtaining International colours in other codes of sports will also be considered and would be allowed to join any club in KwaZulu-Natal.
- 1.7 In the case of injury or illness, the recipients of the Prestige Scholarships may have the award withdrawn and will forego the renewal of the scholarship until they are declared medically fit by a doctor appointed by the Sports Administration.
- 1.8 Any recipient of a Prestige Sports Scholarship who terminates/withdraws from academic registration at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, or if found guilty of breaching any one of the UKZN Rules and Regulations or of the sporting codes will lose the award.
- 1.9 The criteria for the renewal of the scholarship is subject to the candidate meeting minimum progression requirements and continuing to maintain the sporting requirements.
- 1.10 Prestige Sports Scholarships are potentially renewable for the duration of the minimum period of study of the original undergraduate qualification for which the recipient initially registered and will be at the discretion of the Scholarships Committee. Exceptions may be made by the Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee.

2. PROCEDURES

- 2.1 Scholarships will be awarded by the end of November preceding the year for which scholarships are valid. Payment of the scholarship will be made into the recipient's fee account after registration the following year.
- 2.2 The closing date for receipt of applications is 31 October of the year preceding that for which the scholarship is applied.
- 2.3 Application forms are available from the Head of Sports : Westville & Pietermaritzburg and also from our website : <http://studentfunding.ukzn.ac.za>
- 2.4 Applicants must apply *to the centre where they intend studying. Durban Centre: Medical School, Howard College, Westville & Edgewood or Pietermaritzburg Centre.*

B. UNDERGRADUATES

Any South African citizen who is a full-time registered student at the University of KwaZulu-Natal is eligible to apply. The number of scholarships available will be determined on an annual basis and will cover full tuition costs at the University of KwaZulu-Natal.

1 . CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1.1 The criterion for the award shall be achievement in sport at a National or Provincial level.
- 1.2 Preference will be given to sporting codes which are supported by the university.
- 1.3 Satisfactory academic performance for consideration for initial scholarship awards is based on having met minimum progression requirement for the qualification for which the candidate is registered.
- 1.4 Candidates with exceptional achievements such as obtaining International colours in other codes of sports will also be considered and would be allowed to join any club in KwaZulu-Natal.
- 1.5 The recipient must become an active member of the appropriate University of KwaZulu-Natal club and must be a regular player/ competitor throughout the season, and must attend coaching sessions and/or competitions as requested by the club. Failure to observe any of these conditions will result in the cancellation of the scholarship.
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- 1.7 Any recipient of a Prestige Sports Scholarship who terminates/withdraws from academic registration at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, or if found guilty of breaching any one of the UKZN Rules and Regulations or of the sporting codes will lose the award.
- 1.8 The criteria for the renewal of the scholarship is subject to the candidate meeting minimum progression requirements and continuing to maintain the sporting requirements.
- 1.9 Prestige Sports Scholarships are potentially renewable for the duration of the minimum period of study of the original undergraduate qualification for which the recipient initially

registered and will be at the discretion of the Committee. Exceptions may be made by the Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee.

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- 2.1 Scholarships will be awarded by the end of November preceding the year for which scholarships are valid. Payment of the scholarship will be made into the recipient's fee account after registration the following year.
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C. POSTGRADUATES

Any South African citizen who is a full-time registered student at the University of KwaZulu-Natal is eligible to apply. The number of scholarships available will be determined on an annual basis and will cover full tuition costs at the University of KwaZulu-Natal. The Sports Scholarship does not fund Postgraduate Diplomas, Postgraduate Certificates, Part time studies, or self-funded programmes, such as MBA.

1. CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1.1. The criterion for the award shall be achievement in sport at a National or Provincial level.
- 1.2. Preference will be given to sporting codes which are supported by the university.
- 1.3. Satisfactory academic performance for consideration for initial scholarship awards are defined as having completed your primary degree, honours degree or master's degree and accepted into a postgraduate qualification in UKZN.
- 1.4. Candidates with exceptional achievements such as obtaining International colours in other codes of sports will also be considered and would be allowed to join any club in KwaZulu-Natal.
- 1.5. The recipient must become an active member of the appropriate University of KwaZulu-Natal club and must be a regular player/ competitor throughout the season, and must attend coaching sessions and/or competitions as requested by the club. Failure to observe any of these conditions will result in the cancellation of the scholarship.
- 1.6. In the case of injury or illness, the recipients of the Prestige Scholarships may have the award withdrawn and will forego the renewal of the scholarship until they are declared medically fit by a doctor appointed by the Sports Administration.
- 1.7. Any recipient of a Prestige Sports Scholarship who terminates/withdraws from academic registration at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, or if found guilty of breaching any one of the UKZN Rules and Regulations or of the sporting codes will lose the award.
- 1.8. The criteria for the renewal of the scholarship is subject to the candidate meeting minimum progression requirements and continuing to maintain the sporting requirements.
- 1.9. Prestige Sports Scholarships are potentially renewable for the duration of the minimum period of study of the postgraduate qualification for which the recipient

initially registered and will be at the discretion of the Committee. Exceptions may be made by the Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee.

2 . PROCEDURES

- 2.1 Scholarships will be awarded by the end of November preceding the year for which scholarships are valid. Payment of the scholarship will be made into the recipient's fee account after registration the following year.
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D. GENERAL

- 1 . Sports Administration will forward a detailed spreadsheet (indicating their nominations) of all applicants together with the completed sports application forms to Student Funding.
- 2 . Student Funding will forward the completed documentation to all members of the committee prior to the meeting.
- 3 . Recipients will be advised in writing after the meeting by Student Funding.
