









## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR A SIX WEEK ONLINE PROGRAMME AND EXCHANGE WITH UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND SOUTH AFRICAN HBIs, IN 2025.

The HBI xperience (HBIx) project aims to address gaps in research collaborations and partnerships between Historically Black Institutions (HBIs) in the United States and South Africa. Through a student-faculty exchange, participants will create community-based research projects focused on digital humanities and storytelling, aligning with U.S. Embassy goals to strengthen institutional linkages and foster STEM education partnerships.

The call is open to three 2nd year undergraduate students in the Schools of Education, Engineering, Life Sciences and Chemistry. The program invites second-year undergraduate students from academic areas including **Education**, **STEAM**, **Environmental Studies**, **Humanities**, **Art**, **and Digital Studies**.

Participants will come from the following institutions in the United States: **Bennett College, Morehouse** College, Clark Atlanta University, and one U.S. community college. South African institutions include the University of KwaZulu-Natal, Mangosuthu University of Technology, University of Zululand, and Coastal KZN TVET College.

Participants will engage in a six-week virtual course on Pan-African and Indigenous Knowledge theoretical frameworks and digital humanities, pre-orientation activities, a faculty-student exchange Capstone in South Africa, and attend a conference in Washington, D.C.
