



## **CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR A SEMESTER ABROAD VIA THE ERASMUS + MOBILITY SCHOLARSHIP AT the University of Hradec Králové (UHK) – Czech Republic**

The Erasmus+ Project has been established based on the collaboration between UKZN and the University of Hradec Králové in the Czech Republic.

The call is open to Honours, Masters and PhD level students in the disciplines of Development Studies, Political Science, History, Archaeology and Philosophy for the winter term 2025/2026 (from September 2025 to January 2026) within the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility programme). PhD students from Sociology and Social Work can apply for the 1-month research mobility.

There are 3 scholarships for UKZN students for the winter term of 4 months and 2 scholarships for a 1-month research mobility for a PhD student only. The PhD student on a research mobility will not study any courses but concentrate on research for his/her dissertation thesis and will have a UHK supervisor.

Masters level students need to register for courses of at least 30 ECTS credits and PhD students for courses of at least 20 ECTS credits if they are accepted for the full-term mobility. The course catalogue is attached. The PhD students will have a supervisor at UHK with whom they will consult progress on their dissertation.

Students who have been selected for a mobility period within the LLP (Lifelong Learning Programme) or the Erasmus+ for Study or for Internships can apply provided the total number of months of their past/current mobility and the ones they are applying for does not exceed 12 months within the same level of study.

### **GRANT FOR candidate:**

Individual support for stay for the long mobility (4 months) is 3200 EUR and one month research mobility is of 800 EUR. The travel scholarship of 1500 EUR for both types of mobilities.



The student will get both the individual support and the travel scholarship after their arrival to the UHK and after they have opened a bank account in a Czech bank (they will be helped by a Czech volunteer). Selected students must budget for some expenses before the mobility eg. visa fees, medical insurance, flight ticket and some money for the journey and first two weeks of stay in the Czech Republic.

**Deadline for the applications: 27 March 2025**

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

1. A professional CV
2. A letter of motivation
3. Copy of passport (must be valid at least 6 months after the end of the mobility, i.e. July 2026) or if you do not have one a passport and is not able to get one on time, it is necessary to present at least a confirmation that you have applied for one.
4. Scan of a colour passport size photo
5. A letter of recommendation from a UKZN academic
6. A copy of a most recent academic record
7. Proof of registration for 2025 academic year
8. A completed UKZN student exchange application form (if you are planning to transfer credits upon your return to UKZN after the mobility)
9. Learning Agreement (Master's level students need to register for courses of at least 30 ECTS credits and PhD students for courses of at least 20 ECTS credits if they are accepted for the full-term mobility)

A Selection Committee will interview eligible candidates.
