CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR AN ERASMUS + MOBILITY SCHOLARSHIP AT SIEDLCE UNIVERSITY - POLAND

The Erasmus+ Project has been established based on the collaboration between UKZN and the Siedlce University in Poland.

The call is open to a 2nd, or 3rd, or 4th year PhD student in the School of Education for the Winter 2025 semester from October 2025 – mid-February 2026 to spend a semester at Siedlce University. The candidate will only be eligible from the Pedagogy area of Early Childhood Development.

Students who have been selected for a mobility period within the Erasmus+ for Study or for Internships can apply provided the total number of months of their past/current mobility and the ones they are applying for does not exceed 12 months within the same level of study.



GRANT FOR CANDIDATE:

The scholarship for a semester is; 1735 EUR for travel expenses and **800 Euro** per month for living expenses for a stay of 150 days. Students who stay shorter will receive a bit less than 4000 Euro.

Student receives 80 percent after arrival and after opening a bank account in Euros, and 20 percent when the semester is over and when they receive the students transcript of records with grades. For this scholarship, a student is obliged to pay for flight tickets in advance. The health insurance and visa costs are the student's own expense.

Single-room accommodation can cost approximately 168 Euro per month and twin-room accommodation can cost approximately 112 Euro per month.
