The Department of Paediatrics and Child wishes to appoint paediatricians to support both teaching and clinical service delivery. Appointees will be expected to contribute to the teaching of undergraduate and postgraduate students, as well as provide clinical care. The role is intended to provide clinical service provision to support the development of paediatric specialists and sub-specialist training on the UKZN Decentralized Clinical Training Platform (DCTP).
