The Department of Diabetes and Endocrinology is seeking a dynamic and experienced individual to fill the position of Research Phlebotomist for the DISCOVER ME-SOUTH AFRICA (DMSA) study, through a partnership between University of KwaZulu-Natal (UKZN), Inkosi Albert Luthuli Central Hospital (IALCH) Department of Health (DOH) and Omnigen Biodata Limited, UK.

The Phlebotomist is responsible for recruiting and enrolling participants and obtaining biological samples from study participants using standard procedures. They will be responsible for collecting adequate samples so that they can be analysed in the laboratory.

Use standard procedures to obtain adequate quality and volumes of blood samples for research purposes, in line with participant consent, and without harming the patient.

Correctly assign sample identifiers (IDs) to study participants using a secure online software on a tablet device.
