The Water Sanitation & Hygiene Research & Development (WASH R&D) Centre in the School of Engineering is an externally funded team of professional researchers working on multidisciplinary research projects in the urban and industrial water and sanitation, and health sector. A current primary focus of the Centre's laboratory is the testing of biohazardous materials (human waste which includes faecal matter and urine) processed by new sanitation technologies. The Centre is looking for a research assistant to provide support in the biochemical engineering laboratory in the field of Water Sanitation and Hygiene. The incumbent will provide testing support to sanitation technology developers, WASH Centre and students from the School of Chemical Engineering.

The Incumbent must have experiencing in operating laboratory equipment and familiar with good lab practices for handling chemicals and samples. The incumbent will be responsible for onsite field sampling, sample analysis, laboratory quality control, operation and maintenance of equipment. S/he must have in depth knowledge of SHEQ systems, preventative measures and laboratory best practices.
