- Publish at least three (3) journal articles per year in Quartile 1 or 2 journals
- Engage in high-impact international collaborations within the REACH-PSM research network
- Actively contribute to policy development and technology adoption strategies
- Participate in knowledge exchange activities, workshops, and conferences

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Preference will be given to candidates who hold a PhD in a relevant STEM discipline (Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics) and/or possess business or financial modeling skills
- Candidates with a STEM background together with experience in community-informed implementation science will be an asset
- Proven track record of peer-reviewed journal publications, book chapters, and conference presentations in renewable energy, engineering, commercialization, marketing, and business science communication or a related field will be an asset
- Business or financial modeling expertise will be an asset
- Ability to work in an interdisciplinary and international research environment
- Strong analytical, writing, and communication skills
