#### **Keynote Speaker:**

#### **Professor Ashwin Desai**

Ashwin Desai is Professor of Sociology at the University of Johannesburg. In 2021 he was awarded the National Institute for Humanities and Social Sciences (NIHSS) Prize for Best Non-Fiction monograph for Wentworth: The Beautiful Game and Making of Place. He repeated this feat with a 2024 NIHSS Award for Best Non-Fiction Monograph for Durban's Casbah: Bunny Chows, Bolsheviks and Bioscopes (co-authored with Goolam Vahed). In 2023 he received the HSRC and USAF Award for Established Researcher and in 2024 the Top Researcher Award, Faculty of Humanities, University of Johannesburg.

#### **Dr Janine Hicks**

Dr Janine Hicks is Senior Lecturer at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, School of Law, where she serves as Academic Leader for Community Engagement, and Chairperson of the UKZN Gender Based Violence Committee. Janine is also convenor for the Navi Pillay Research Group, a collective of academics from the School of Law seeking to address critical emergent issues of race, class, gender and disability in post-Apartheid South Africa through research, law and policy reform. Janine further serves as Project Leader for the South African Law Reform Commission's Project 143: Maternity and Paternity Benefits for Self-Employed Workers, and a former Commissioner with the South African Commission for Gender Equality. Janine holds a PhD (UKZN), an MA (Sussex), a post-graduate LLB (Natal) and a BA (UCT). She has published extensively on democracy, public participation, gender equality and access to socio-economic rights.
