

MATH160 and MATH161 Tutor Applications 2026

Tutor applications are now open for MATH160 and MATH161 for 2026.

We are looking for passionate and dedicated Group Tutors and Marking Tutors for the MATH160 (Differential Calculus) and MATH161 (Integral Calculus) tutorial groups.

Requirements:

- You will need to be a full-time registered student for the full year of 2026. MATH160 and MATH161 are year long modules. Your proof of registration will need to be provided after the 2026 registration process.
- You must have gotten at least 75% in MATH131 or MATH130 or MATH160. Preference will be given to students with a higher MATH131 or MATH130 or MATH160 final mark.
- You must have gotten at least 75% in MATH141 or MATH140 or MATH161. Preference will be given to students with a higher MATH141 or MATH140 or MATH161 final mark.
- You need to be in your final year of your undergraduate degree or doing Honours, Masters or Phd. Preference will be given to students who already have their degree/ have more experience.

Previous teaching/tutoring/demonstrating experience is **not** required but preference will be given to candidates with experience.

Responsibilities:

- **Group Tutors** will be responsible for a group of MATH160 or MATH161 students. You will need to attend the weekly tutorial sessions (1.5 hours), check that students have done the assigned work, help students that could not complete the work and manage your group's weekly attendance registers. You will also be responsible for invigilating all class tests that we have in the year during the tutorial period time slots.
- **Marking Tutors** will be responsible for marking a group of MATH160 or MATH161 tutorial tests using a provided marking memo. This will be done weekly after the assessment period. You will **not** be responsible for any class test marking or exam marking.
