HEARD's internship programme is designed to build the capacity of recently graduated young researchers by exposing them to real work situations and projects, and to enhance their ability to conduct scientific research and manage projects. Preference is given to applicants who have conducted health-related research on topics in line with HEARD's research agenda and programmes. Interns are recruited to HEARD for a period of one year and are allocated to HEARD researcher/s to work on research projects as a way of strengthening their research skills.

Responsibilities

- Participation in the conceptualisation and execution of research projects, the formulation of research questions and writing proposals;
- Assisting with the submission of research proposals;
- Collection and analysis of data;
- Writing up of research results, research reports and manuscripts for publication;
- Research administration of research project activities;
- Preparation of a PhD proposal.
