The School caters for both the M- and LES-streams and offers service courses to students in the School of Engineering and in the College of Law and Management Studies. The successful candidate appointed to this position will lecture Statistics, which will include lecturing at the Undergraduate level. Duties include, but may not be restricted to, delivering lectures and tutorials, overseeing student practical sessions, setting and marking tests and exams, student consultation, and attendance at relevant staff meetings. Lectures will be allocated depending on the exact requirements of the School. The incumbent may be required to assist with the co-ordination of aspects of the module. A strong background and knowledge of statistical methods and knowledge of statistical software such as SAS, R, SPSS and Excel.

We invite applications for ad hoc fixed-term contract lecturing positions on the Westville Campus and Pietermaritzburg Campus to start during February 2026. The duration of the appointment will be based on the academic needs of the school. Applicants must be able to teach a module in Introduction to Statistics (first year) to large classes. Experience in coordinating a first-year module will be considered an advantage.

**Minimum requirements:**

- PhD degree in Statistics OR a relevant Master's degree in Statistics with evidence of submission of a PhD for examination.
- Relevant teaching experience at a tertiary institution.
- Evidence of presentations at national or international conferences.
- Current research activity as evidenced by a publication in a quality scientific journal.
