The successful candidates appointed to these part time positions will lecture Mathematics or Applied Mathematics, which will include lecturing at undergraduate and Honours level. Duties include, but may not be restricted to, delivering lectures and tutorials, overseeing student practical sessions, setting and marking tests and exams, student consultation, and attendance at relevant staff meetings. Lectures will be allocated depending on exact requirements of the School.

The Discipline of Mathematics caters for both the M- and LES-streams, and offers service courses to students in the School of Engineering and in the College of Law and Management Studies. We invite applications for *adhoc* fixed term contract lecturing positions on the Pietermaritzburg campus, to start in February 2026. The applicants must be able to teach any of the following modules: Introduction to Calculus (MATH130) (16 credits), Applied Mathematics 1A (MATH132) (16 credits), Quantitative Methods 1 (MATH134) (16 credits), Calculus and Linear Algebra (MATH140) (16 credits), Mathematics for Natural Sciences (MATH150) (16 credits) and Mechanics (MATH235) (16 credits).

The incumbent will report to the Academic Leader in Mathematics.

Minimum requirements:

- A Master's degree in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics
- Experience in teaching in a relevant field at a tertiary institution.
- Evidence of presentation at a national or international conference.
- Current research activity as evidenced by a publication in a quality scientific journal.

REMUNERATION: The all-inclusive remuneration package for the full period of appointment is based on the university's standard rates of pay on a per lecture/tutorial/practical basis.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum requirements will not be considered.
