Duties include teaching and delivering the practical components of the module, student consultations, setting and marking tests and exams, and other duties assigned by the Line Manager. A strong background in GIS and Remote Sensing, including an understanding of physical sciences applications, would be advantageous.

The incumbent will report to the Academic Leader of the Geography Discipline.

Minimum Requirements:

- A PhD degree in the relevant discipline or Masters degree in Environmental Sciences, Geography, with evidence of submission of a PhD for examination.
- Experience in teaching in a relevant field at a tertiary institution.
- Evidence of presentations at national or international conferences.
- Current research activity as evidenced by a publication in quality scientific journals.
