Where applicable, ad hoc lecturers may be required to supervise postgraduate (usually honours level) research projects and undertake any other roles that will be assigned by the Cluster Leader in one or more modules offered in the first semester of 2026.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Masters Degree in the relevant programme. (PhD will be an added advantage)
- Demonstrate excellent knowledge in subject area (such as a good academic record or relevant publications)
- Experience and proficiency in classroom technologies such as Moodle applications
- At least one year's teaching experience at tertiary level
