POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

The University of KwaZulu-Natal is one of the top Universities in South Africa and in the top 500 Universities globally. The Schools in the College of Health Sciences have a long-standing tradition in research and teaching, with vibrant postgraduate research programmes. The Postdoctoral Research Fellowship Programme aims to provide opportunities for exceptional postdoctoral candidates to conduct scholarly inquiry, publish, and increase knowledge in the fields of academic development practice as well as teaching and learning in higher education. Please note that Post-doctoral Fellows are not appointed as employees of the university; therefore, they are not eligible for employee benefits but are awarded tax-free stipends.

BACKGROUND

Provision has been made for the appointment of two Postdoctoral Fellow positions within the Health Professions Education (HPE) Unit. These positions are intended to strengthen the Unit's research, scholarship, and capacity development initiatives in health professions education.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates who hold a PhD in HPE, Higher Education, Psychology, Health Sciences, or a related discipline within the social or health sciences. Candidates with demonstrated experience or interest in educational research, faculty development, curriculum innovation, or technology-enhanced learning will be particularly well suited. South African Citizens (R280 000). Non-South Africans (R200 000).

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A Doctoral degree obtained within the last five years (and not previously funded by UKZN)

- Lead and contribute to the high productivity of the hosting school
- Carry out other duties consistent with a post-doctoral fellowship
- Abide by UKZN's policies, rules and procedures for post-doctoral fellows as well as codes of conduct.
- Additionally, the successful applicant will be required to publish a minimum of 2 research papers per annum in DHET/ISI accredited journals; preferably Q1 rated journals.
- The fellowship is a one-year contract. However, renewal beyond the first year will depend on satisfactory performance in that year and the availability of funding.
- All Non-SA candidates should be in possession of a valid work permit or South African visa (not study visa/permit) to qualify.
- Our HR Policy does not recognize study visas/permits. If in possession of a study visa/permit, it must have a condition which states that the candidate is pursuing Post-doctoral duties.
