The School of Social Science seeks to employ 4 fieldworkers and will be responsible for following up on hard-to-reach participants for day-to-day data collection in Umlazi Ward 79, Ward 82 and Ward 88, using a set of data collection instruments for the Individual Health Data collection round for USINGA. USINGA is a health and demographic surveillance system (HDSS), which is one of seven research nodes of the South African Population Research Infrastructure Network (SAPRIN).

Successful candidates will be expected to have a good grasp of concepts, using this to collect data for the USINGA Individual Health data collection round, ensuring that data is collected accurately, is reliable, and is of good quality. The individual must have the ability to manage sensitive and confidential study information and must be able to work well within a team. Data collection happens in regular rounds and is organized in sequential week blocks.

The successful candidate will be reporting to USINGA Fieldwork Coordinator.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12
- A minimum experience of 1 year in field-based data collection
- Knowledge about HDSS and Longitudinal Surveillance data collection systems
- Must be computer literate, with proficiency in the use of electronic data collection devices (e.g., smartphones/tablets)
- Knowledge on Research Ethics
- Good verbal and written communication skills in English and isiZulu
- Must be a resident and household member from within the USINGA Study area (Umlazi Ward 79, 82 or 88)
