The School of Social Science and Development Studies seeks to employ 6 supervisors who will be responsible for overseeing and supervising day-to-day data collection in Umlazi Ward 79, Ward 82 and Ward 88. USINGA is a Health and Demographic Surveillance System (HDSS). One of seven nodes of the South African Population Research Infrastructure Network (SAPRIN).

Successful candidates will be expected to mentor, supervise, and oversee the collection of data for the USINGA Individual Health data collection round, ensuring that data is collected accurately, is reliable, and is of good quality. The individual must have the ability to manage a team of fieldworkers and be able to use the survey solutions supervisor's dashboard and interview account, in addition, the successful candidate must be able to compile outcome forms, data tracking forms, and compile weekly reports. Supervisors will be required to drive their team members and be able to troubleshoot problems experienced in the field.

The successful candidate will be reporting to the Fieldwork Coordinator.
