The School of Agriculture and Science, a well-established institution with a robust research profile that accommodates a significant number of undergraduate and postgraduate students, seeks to appoint a Senior Technician (Marine) who will contribute substantially to the teaching and research programs in Marine Biology at the Westville Campus. The ideal candidate will possess practical experience in the operation of research vessels and small crafts, as well as proficiency with scientific equipment. The individual will be responsible for setting up aquaria, maintaining and managing the Marine Science unit, and demonstrating a comprehensive understanding of both the theoretical and practical components of the Marine Biology modules offered by the School.

Responsibilities will encompass all aspects of teaching undergraduate practical sessions, providing research support in Marine Biology, including laboratory and equipment maintenance, and the collection of marine specimens and materials. Additionally, the candidate will be tasked with setting up and facilitating training for postgraduate students on the relevant equipment, conducting experiments, and ensuring laboratory safety and cleanliness. The appointee will supervise laboratory staff and will undertake administrative functions and other responsibilities as assigned by management, in alignment with the operational needs of the section.

The incumbent will report to the Manager: Technical Operations.

Minimum Requirements:

- A three-year relevant qualification in Marine Biology or in a related field.
- Four years' relevant work experience in a Marine Biology laboratory.
- Skipper's license. The incumbent must be physically able to launch, handle and retrieve boats.
