The KwaZulu-Natal Research Institute for Tuberculosis and HIV (K-RITH) is an independent basic science research facility. Its mission is to conduct outstanding basic science research on tuberculosis (TB) and HIV and translate the scientific findings into new tools to control TB and HIV. K-RITH was established in 2009 as a non-profit company by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute (HHMI) and the University of KwaZulu-Natal (UKZN). The institute is housed in the K-RITH Tower Building; a state-of-the-art, 4,000 sq. m. research building on the campus of the Nelson R. Mandela School of Medicine of UKZN.

Overview of the position:

The Animal Facility Technical Assistant will be involved in the K-RITH animal breeding operation, currently located in the Biomedical Resource Unit, UKZN, Westville. He/she will take care of husbandry, watering and feeding in the mouse unit. Maintain a level of hygiene in the laboratory area through regular disinfection of corridors and rooms, and the washing of cages, bottles and food hoppers. Assist in execution of research projects as delegated by supervisor. Report animal and husbandry problems to supervisors and technical problems to the laboratory support manager. Perform weekend and holiday duties as required.

Minimum qualifications:

Degree or Diploma in Laboratory Animal Technology or related field and must be Computer Literate.

Experience required:

Equivalent combination of experience from which comparable knowledge, skills and abilities have been achieved.
